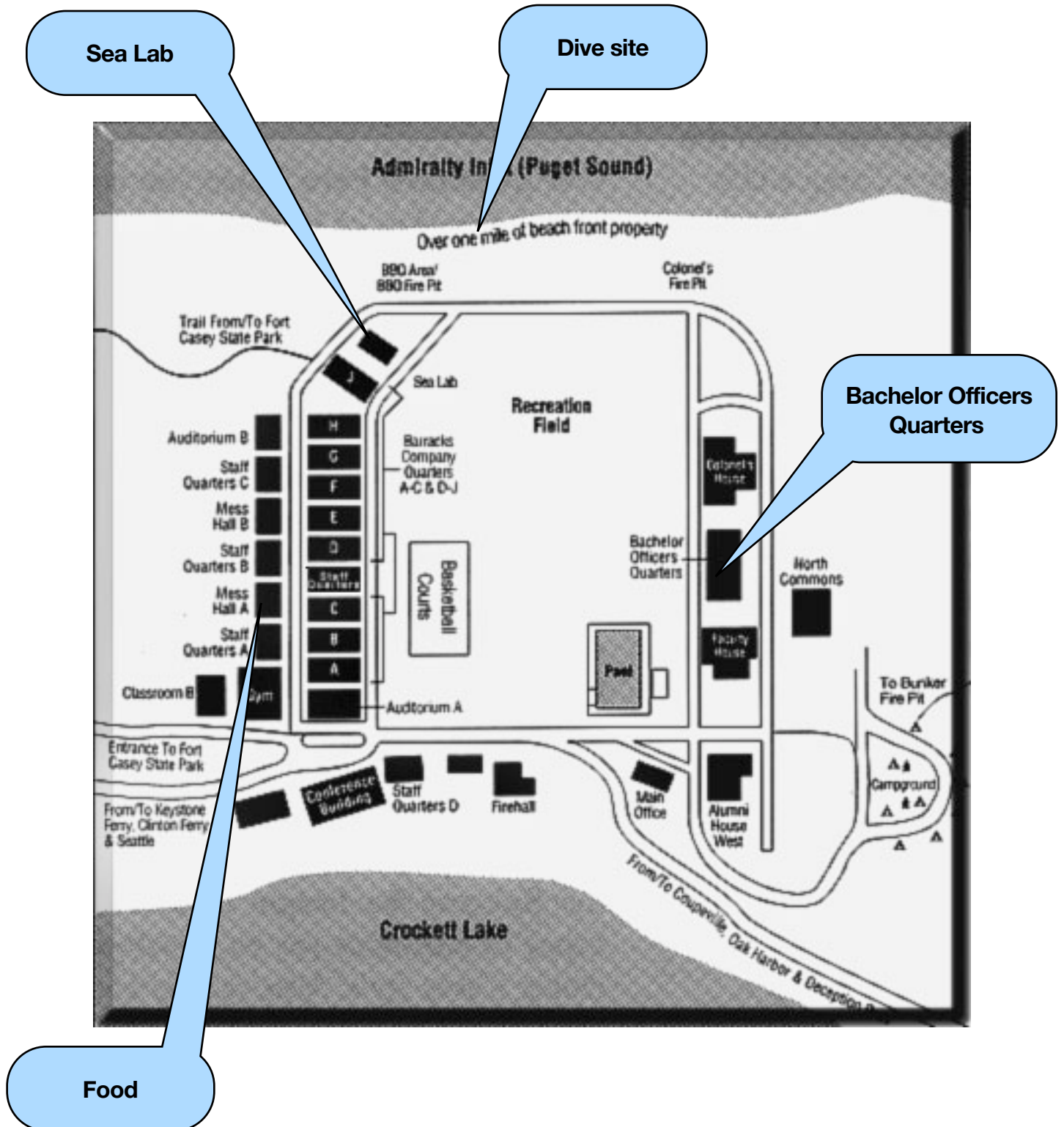

# Current Calculations

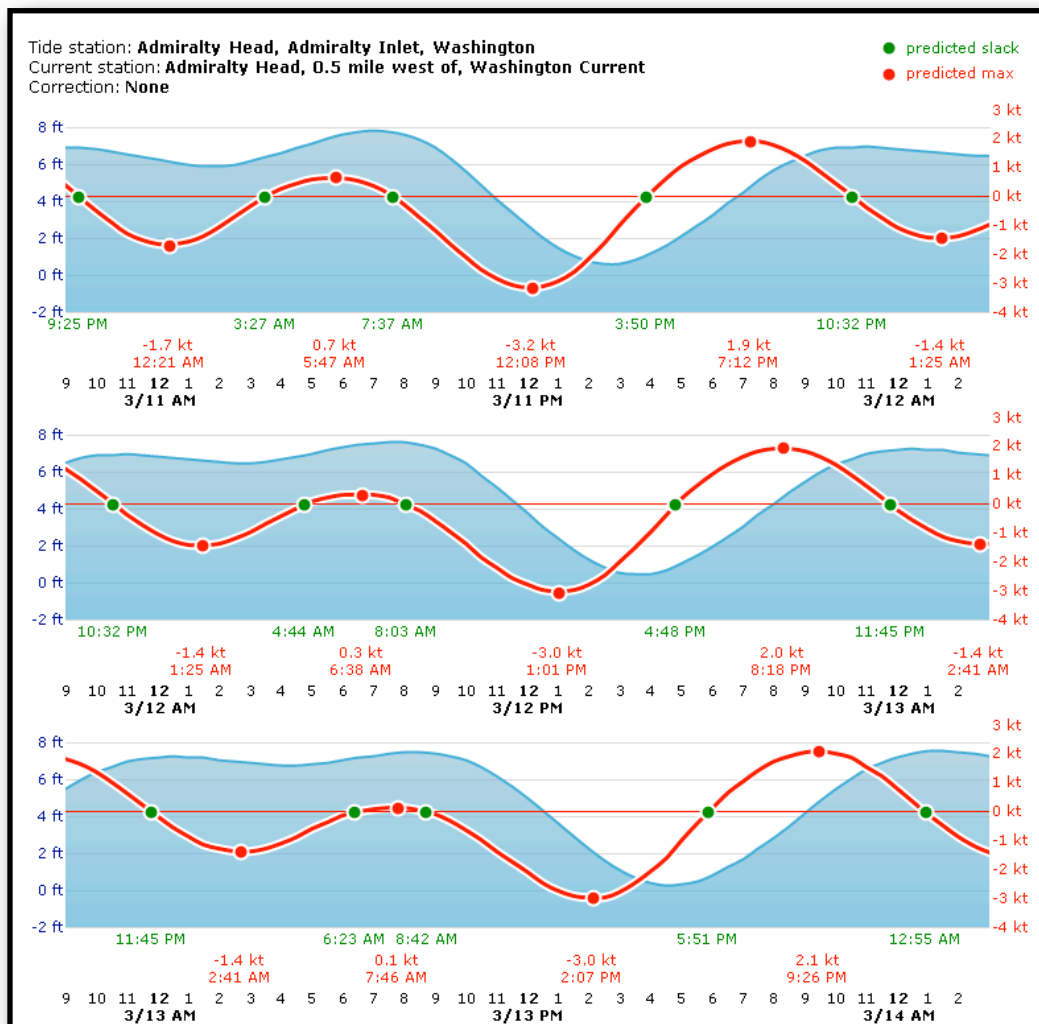

Currents for Camp Casey this year are in the morning. As you recall it is best to dive here on slack before ebb and to dive the Keystone jetty on the slack before flood. We have never timed the slacks precisely but only know that they seem to occur between the predicted slacks for the Admiralty Head, 0.5 miles W of station and the Point Wilson, 2.3 miles NE of station. The slacks before ebbs at those two stations are:

	Admiralty Head	Point Wilson,
	0.5 miles W of	2.3 miles NE of
Saturday	8:34 AM	8:03 AM
Sunday	10:14 AM	9:42 AM

Please note that we go on daylight savings time Sunday, March 13. If you look at the Plan Your Dive website they do not compensate for DST so the time they list for slacks are off by an hour. The beginning of DST is why the slacks jump almost 2 hours between Saturday and Sunday.

My suggestion for the Camp Casey dives would be to be ready to splash 30-45 minutes before the earlier slack and then watch the water. That would make the splash times as early as 7:15 on Saturday and 9:00 on Sunday. The floods that precede these slacks are very mild 0.26 and 0.10 knots respectively, so it is entirely possible that you may be able to start your dives even earlier if anyone cares to. On Sunday, the flood may never really occur. Friday and Saturday will have nice mid-afternoon splash times for Keystone Jetty.
